Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Funding for system of learning results. Notwithstanding Public Law 1995, chapter 649, sections 2 to 5; Resolve 1997, chapter 51; or any other provisions of law or rule, any expenditures that result from implementing the system of learning results must be paid by the State.

Sec. 2. Professional development. Notwithstanding Public Law 1995, chapter 649, sections 6 and 7 or any other provisions of law or rule, any costs related to professional development must be paid by the State.
