2,000 permits; ~~and~~

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Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§2-A, ¶E is enacted to read:

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E. In 2000 and in each year thereafter, a number of permits
determined annually by the commissioner.

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SUMMARY

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This bill provides that in the year 2000 and in each year
thereafter the number of moose permits awarded will be determined
24 annually by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.
