	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §85, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

	6. Ambulance operator course. Beginning January 1, 2002, a
6	person who routinely operates an ambulance that is being operated
	in an emergency mode or transporting a patient must successfully
8	complete a basic ambulance vehicle operator course or a course
	that has been approved by the board as an equivalent. This
10	requirement is in addition to any vehicle operator requirements
	of Title 29-A or other provision of law.

16	This bill requires a person who routinely operates an ambulance to complete an ambulance operator course beginning
18	January 1, 2002.
