### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §2903, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by PL 1997, c. 738, §2, is amended to read:
- 1. Excise tax imposed. An excise tax is imposed on internal combustion engine fuel used or sold within this State, including sales to the State or a political subdivision of the State, at the rate of 19ø 14¢ per gallon, except that the rate is 3.4¢ per gallon on internal combustion engine fuel, as defined in section 2902, bought or used for the purpose of propelling jet or turbojet engine aircraft.

This bill reduces the gasoline tax by 5 ¢ from 19 ¢ per gallon to 14 ¢ per gallon.
