COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 474, L.D. 681

in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01 for the Department of
Education to develop a grant program to support public school alliances. No funding for this program is currently included in
the Governor's proposed "current services" budget.

6 The Department of Education will incur some minor additional costs to adopt rules to implement the grant program. These costs 8 can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

14 This amendment limits the number of grants to support public school alliances under the bill to 20 per year and requires the Department of Education to adopt rules that establish a preference in awarding grants to school alliances that obtain local matching funds.
