2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §1215**, as amended by PL 1991, c. 591, Pt. E,
§13, is further amended to read:

6 **§1215. Mileage and compensation of jurors**

8 A juror is entitled to paid mileage at the rate of 15¢ per
10 mile for travel expenses from the juror's residence to the place
of holding court and return, ~~to reimbursement of parking expenses~~
12 and to compensation at the rate of \$10 for each day of required
attendance at sessions of the court.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill requires a court to reimburse jurors for the
18 jurors' parking expenses.
