

2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
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6 **Whereas,** the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5,
chapter 375, subchapter II-A, requires legislative authorization
before major substantive agency rules may be finally adopted by
the agency; and
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10 **Whereas,** the above named major substantive rules have been
submitted to the Legislature for review; and
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14 **Whereas,** immediate enactment of this resolve is necessary to
record the Legislature's position on final adoption of these
rules; and
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18 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, be it
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24 **Sec. 1. Adoption. Resolved:** That final adoption of Chapter
64: Rules Relating to the Maine School Facilities Program and
School Revolving Renovation Fund, provisionally adopted major
substantive rules of the Department of Education and the Maine
Municipal Bond Bank, submitted to the Legislature for review
pursuant to the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, is authorized.
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30 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

36 This resolve provides for legislative review of Chapter 64:
Rules Relating to the Maine School Facilities Program and School
Revolving Renovation Fund, major substantive rules of the
Department of Education. These rules govern the application and
approval process for projects to be considered through the School
Revolving Renovation Fund; Facility Maintenance and Capital
Improvement Programs; Maine School Facilities Finance Program and
lease and lease/purchase of temporary interim space and small
nonadministrative space.
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
