28	1-A. Artificial breathing device prohibited. A person may not fish for or take soft shell clams while using an artificial

32 34	under section 6072, 6072-A or 6072-B when fishing for or taking soft shell clams cultivated on the leased area.
34	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the

42	This bill may increase prosecutions for Class D crimes. If a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties are estimated to be \$82.48 per day per prisoner. These costs are
44	not reimbursed by the State. The number of prosecutions that may

result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

The additional workload, administrative costs and indigent defense costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

## 12 SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits the use of an artificial breathing device when fishing for or taking soft shell clams but exempts the holder of an aquaculture lease from the prohibition when fishing for or taking soft shell clams cultivated on the leased area. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
