With respect to persons receiving mental health services funded in whole or in part by the Department of Mental 22 Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services, to members of the local service networks, pursuant to Title 24 34-B, section 3608, when necessary to perform the duties of the networks. 26 28 SUMMARY 30 This bill restricts the release of mental health information among members of local service networks to information concerning 32 persons whose care is paid for in whole or in part by the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance 34 Abuse Services.
