FISCAL NOTE

This bill may reduce prosecutions for Class E crimes. If the number of jail sentences is reduced, the savings to the counties are estimated to be \$83.36 per day per prisoner. The amount of any reduction of jail time and the resulting savings to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

SUMMARY

18 This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment allows a person who possesses a valid fishing license and has suffered the physical loss of an arm to use any type of rod and reel to fish with a fly on waters open to fly-fishing. The term "loss of an arm" means the physical loss of the arm above the wrist. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
