Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Date for rules submission; authorization for legislation. Rules provisionally adopted in accordance with this Act must be submitted to the Legislature for review no later than January 1, 2000. The Joint Standing Committee of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry may report out legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 119th Legislature pertaining to fees for licensing sellers and dealers in nursery stock.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

### FISCAL NOTE

Authorizing the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to establish nursery license fees by rule may increase or decrease dedicated revenues collected by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources. The net effect on the collection of fees is expected to be insignificant.

The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will incur some minor additional costs to adopt certain rules which establish nursery license fees. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

This bill may increase the number of civil violations filed in the court system. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

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#### **SUMMARY**

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This amendment provides for the current fee structure to stay in place until major substantive rules are adopted to set fees. It directs the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to provisionally adopt rules and submit them to the Legislature for review no later than January 1, 2000. authorizes the Joint Standing Committee Agriculture, of Conservation and Forestry to report out legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 119th Legislature pertaining to fees for licensing sellers and dealers in nursery stock. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
