HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 543,  
L.D. 750, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Patient's Bill of Rights"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 21 the following:

**'Sec. 22. Appropriation; State Employee Health Insurance Reserve.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

**State Employee Health Insurance Reserve**

All Other	\$900,000
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Provides for the appropriation of funds to pay for potential increases in premiums for state employees due to the effects of this Act. These funds do not lapse but must be carried forward.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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## FISCAL NOTE

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This amendment increases the General Fund cost of the bill by \$900,000 in fiscal year 2000-01.

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8 As amended, this bill includes a General Fund appropriation  
10 of \$900,000 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of  
12 Administrative and Financial Services, State Employee Health  
Insurance Reserve to pay for potential increases in health  
insurance premiums for state employees due to the effects of the  
Patient's Bill of Rights.


