18 Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first  
20 indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 22 to 25 in  
amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

22 'Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 (page 1,  
24 lines 3 to 31 in L.D.)'

26 Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part  
designated "**§1326-A.**" in the first paragraph by striking out all  
of the last 2 sentences (page 1, lines 48 to 50 and page 2, lines  
28 1 to 5 in amendment)

30 Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 5  
(page 3, lines 34 to 52 in amendment)

34 Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 5 the  
following:

36 'Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any  
38 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read  
consecutively.'

42 **FISCAL NOTE**

44 This amendment eliminates the provision dedicating interest  
earnings, eliminating the General Fund revenue reductions and the

14 victims. The amendment also strikes the allocation section from  
the committee amendment.
