COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 271, L.D. 764, Bill, "An Act to Amend Certain Aviation Laws"

Amend the bill in section 9 in section 2 in paragraph A in the 6th line (page 3, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "shall" the following: 'except with prior permission from the owner,'

Further amend the bill in section 10 by striking out all of subsection 6 (page 3, lines 37 to 49 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'6. Private airports with commercial activity. The commissioner shall issue registration certificates for private airports with commercial activity. A fee of \$50 for each registration must be paid by the owner. Prior to the issuance of the registration, the private airport with commercial activity must at least meet the minimum standards that are contained in chapter 6. The registration certificate is valid until January 1st of the next calendar year unless sooner revoked, suspended or cancelled.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

The Department of Transportation will incur some minor additional costs to inspect certain airports. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.
