COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 549, L.D. 770, Bill, "An Act to Make the Laws Governing State Ambient Air Quality for Ozone and Particulate Matter Consistent with Federal Requirements"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 25 and 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "84 parts per billion" and inserting in its place the following: '.08 parts per ~~billion~~ million'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the ozone particulate standard from 84 parts per billion to .08 parts per million to mirror the National Ozone Standard.
