

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7105, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1993, c. 574, §10, is further amended to read:

2. Fee. The fee for a special commercial shooting area hunting license is \$17 for 1994, \$18 for 1995 and \$19 for 1996 and every year after 1996.

A. The fee for a 3-day license is \$9.00. This amount must be credited against the yearly fee if the licensee applies for a special commercial shooting area hunting license in the same year.

B. The commissioner may waive the requirement for a special commercial shooting area license for a person who completes a safe hunter course.

SUMMARY

This bill establishes a reduced fee for a 3-day special commercial shooting area hunting license and allows the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to waive the license requirement for a hunter who completes the safe hunter course.
