Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 4 in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 17 and 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "if such powers are vested in the municipal council by municipal charter" and inserting in its place the following: 'if the charter does not require a referendum'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies the intent of the bill to allow a municipal school unit to approve a locally funded school construction project without a local referendum if the municipality operates under a charter that does not require a referendum for construction projects.
