2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §2903**, as amended by PL 1985, c. 32, is  
6 further amended by adding after the 18th indented paragraph a new  
8 indented paragraph to read:

10 It is unlawful for any person to sell any unpasteurized milk  
12 product unless the milk product is labeled "This product has not  
14 been pasteurized."
