28	Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5 in paragraph A in subparagraph (1) in the first line (page 1, line
30 32	35 in L.D.) by striking out the following: " <u>1993</u> " and inserting in its place the following: ' <u>2000</u> '
52	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the

20	'FISCAL NOTE
38	This bill will increase the future costs of the State's
40	workers' compensation plan beginning in fiscal year 2005-06. Based on the number of current state employees receiving
42	compensation for total and partial incapacity, the annual adjustments in payments for state employees may be as much as
44	\$22,000 annually.'
46	SUMMARY
48	
50	This amendment makes the cost-of-living adjustment prospective for injuries occurring on or after January, 1, 2000 instead of retroactive to January 1, 1993 as in the bill. This
52	amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
