This amendment clarifies that school administrative units receive state subsidy for any student enrolled in an equivalent instruction program who receives instruction through one or more on-site academic courses from a public school but is not a full-time student. Under this amendment, school administrative units that send tuition students to another school administrative unit or to a private school pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 219 are also entitled to receive state subsidy for these students. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT
