

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 **Sec. 1.** 29-A MRS §1002, sub-§1, ¶¶E and F, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, are amended to read:

8 E. Use by customers for not more than 7 days to demonstrate the vehicle; or

10 F. Use by the manufacturer or dealer when the combined weight of the vehicle and the load does not exceed 10,000 pounds unless the vehicle, by design, exceeds 10,000 pounds without a load; or

14 **Sec. 2.** 29-A MRS §1002, sub-§1, ¶G is enacted to read:

18 ~~G. Test driving or driving to and from an inspection station a motorcycle that a dealer has taken in trade.~~

22 **SUMMARY**

24 This bill allows a vehicle dealer who has taken a motorcycle in trade for a vehicle either to test the motorcycle or drive it to and from an inspection station using a dealer plate.
