Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §401, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104, Pt. C, §8, is further amended to read:

3. Meetings with municipal officers. At least annually, the county commissioners and sheriff shall may hold a special meeting for reviewing county law enforcement activities. The county commissioners shall may set a date, time and place for this meeting and inform the sheriff and all municipal officers, including all municipal police chiefs within the county, of the meeting at least one week in advance. The purpose of this meeting is to review activities of the sheriff's department, to coordinate law enforcement activities throughout the county and to resolve problems in law enforcement.

SUMMARY

This bill makes optional the annual meeting between county officials and municipal officers concerning operation of sheriffs' departments.
