COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 585, L.D. 825, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Frequency With Which Message Boards May Change Their Message"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in the last line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "10" and inserting in its place the following: '20'

SUMMARY

This is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. The bill proposed to allow a public school to change the message on its changeable message sign every 10 minutes. The amendment increases that to every 20 minutes.
