**'Sec. 1. Integrated pest management program for cranberries; University of Maine Cooperative Extension.** The funding for the integrated pest management program for cranberries at the University of Maine Cooperative Extension first provided in fiscal year 1998-99 in Private and Special Law 1997, chapter 93 and currently funded at approximately \$50,000 per year is ongoing funding to be used for that purpose only. Any cost-of-living adjustments provided for the "current services" budget of the University of Maine System must also be applied to the funding for this program.'
