

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§3**, as amended by PL 1997, c.
643, Pt. 00, §1 and affected by §3, is further amended to read:

6 **3. Payment by State.** The State shall pay ~~30%~~ 50% of the
8 retired teacher members' share of this insurance.
