2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
4	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1605, sub-§1, ¶C, as amended by PL 1997, c. 176, §5 and affected by §8, is further amended to read:
6	C. Be in the amount or limit of at least:
8	(1) For damage to property, \$25,000 <u>\$10,000</u> ;
10	(2) For injury to or death of any one person, \$50,000 <u>\$20,000; and</u>
12 14	(3) For one accident resulting in injury to or death of more than one person, \$1 00,000,-and <u>\$40,000.</u>

26	1. Satisfaction. To meet the obligation of financial responsibility only, a judgment is satisfied:
28	A. When \$59,999 <u>\$20,000</u> has been credited on a judgment for bodily injury to or death of one person as the result of one
30	accident rendered in excess of that amount;
32	B. Subject to paragraph A, when \$100,000 <u>\$40,000</u> has been credited on a judgment for bodily injury to or death of 2 or
34	more people as the result of one accident rendered in excess of that amount; or
36	C. When \$25,999 <u>\$10,000</u> has been credited on a judgment for
38	injury to or destruction of property of others as a result of one accident rendered in excess of that amount.

42	Sec. 4. Applicability. Those sections of this Act that amend the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, sections 1605 and 1607
44	and repeal section 1605-A apply to all personal motor vehicle liability policies executed, delivered, issued for delivery,
46	continued or renewed in this State on or after November 1, 1999. For purposes of this Act, all policies are deemed to be renewed no later than the next yearly anniversary of the policy date.
