22	This bill requires that a person attach a tag to each anchor
	used on the elver fyke nets. The tag must include the person's
24	name and elver fishing license number. The bill also requires
	that elver fyke net anchors be removed from rivers, streams and
26	brooks when the elver fyke net is removed.
