Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1997, c. 432, §45, is further amended to read:

3. Dates and length of season. On or after January 1, 1982, the commissioner may establish open seasons on moose within the moose hunting zones established by the commissioner under subsection 1-A, as long as each moose hunting season is within the last full week of September and the number of hunting days in each year does not exceed 6.
