_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-U is enacted to read:
-	<u>\$3174-U. Medical assistance for low-income persons</u>
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	1. Program established. The department shall operate a
8	program designated MaineCare to provide medical assistance to
	adult Maine residents who are ineligible for Medicaid with
10	incomes below 125% of the federal nonfarm income official poverty
	line.
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	2. Services. Medical services provided under this section
14	include those services provided by the Medicaid program.
16	3. Administration. Except as otherwise provided in this
	section, the MaineCare program must be integrated with the
18	Medicaid program and administered with it in one administrative
	structure within the department, with the same enrollment and
20	eligibility processes, and in compliance with the same laws and
	policies as the Medicaid program.
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	4. Advisory committee jurisdiction. The Medicaid Advisory
24	Council authorized under federal regulation shall advise the
26	department on the operation of the MaineCare program.
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20	5. Maximization of federal funds. The department shall
28	maximize the use of federal funds to the extent available in
30	order to minimize expenditures under the MaineCare program. To maximize the use of federal funds, the department shall take all
30	reasonable and necessary steps to apply for and seek federal
32	Medicaid waivers or any demonstration grants.

34	6. Coordination of benefits. Any application for food
	stamps, TANF or Medicaid must be treated as an application for

38	7. Rules. The department shall adopt rules to implement
	and govern the MaineCare program. Rules adopted pursuant to this
40	section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5,
	<u>chapter 375, subchapter II-A.</u>

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ΨV	This bill creates the MaineCare program to provide medical assistance to needy Maine individuals with incomes under 125% of
48	the federal poverty level.
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
