2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7630, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

6 5. Age. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,  
8 licensees who have attained 70 years of age and persons who have  
10 not yet attained 16 years of age may take fish by any method.
