HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 619, L.D. 859, Bill, "An Act to Require that the State Planning Office Report to the Committee on State and Local Government"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Require the State Planning Office to Report to the Committee on State and Local Government and the Committee on Natural Resources''

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the first paragraph on page 2 (page 2, line 2 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 4 by striking out all of paragraph I-1 and inserting in its place the following:

'I-1. Make reports annually to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resource matters detailing the activities of the office regarding land issues and, after consultation with and approval of the Governor, submit recommendations for legislative action as determined necessary to further the purposes of this chapter: ' '
