The State Board of Education and the Department of Education plan will be presented to the 120th Legislature no later than January 15, 2001 and must include a review of the 40 rules related to the protected status of projects in the current 42 2-year rating cycle, a review of the debt service limits and consideration of a "hold harmless" provision related to actions 44 taken by local school administrative units to remediate existing Priority I health or safety issues as defined by Department of 46 Education rules. The amendment also appropriates the projected balance in the 48 General Fund revenue remaining from the Second Regular Session's 50 budgeting process as a one-time appropriation to further
