Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15905, sub-§1, ¶A, as repealed and replaced by PL 1997, c. 469, §2, is amended to read:

A. The state board may approve projects as long as no project approval will--cause--causes debt service costs, as defined in section 15603, subsection 8, paragraph A, to exceed the maximum limits specified in Table 1 in subsequent fiscal years.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
