HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 302, L.D. 873, Bill, "An Act to Clarify Municipal Responsibility for the Maintenance of Veterans' Gravesites"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out the first 2 lines (page 2, lines 19 and 20 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 2. 13 MRSA §§1101-A to 1101-E are enacted to read:'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by inserting at the end the following:

'§1101-E. Graves on land owned by Federal Government

Veterans' graves as described in section 1101 that are located on a site that was owned by the Federal Government as of January 1, 2000 are not subject to the requirements of section 1101.'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 by inserting at the end the following:

'6. Graves on land owned by Federal Government. Veterans' graves located on a site that was owned by the Federal Government as of January 1, 2000 are not subject to the requirements of this section.'
