FISCAL NOTE

This amendment increases the General Fund cost of the bill by \$18,435 in fiscal year 2000-01.

10 The requirement that municipalities place individual flags for Memorial Day on the graves of all wartime veterans located in 12 each municipality or organized township represents a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The additional 14 cost of this state mandate is estimated to be approximately \$20,483 annually.

As amended, this bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$18,435 in fiscal year 2000-01 to the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management to reimburse municipalities for the costs of placing individual flags for Memorial Day on the graves of all wartime veterans. This appropriation represents 90% of the total cost of the state mandate.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the mandate preamble from the bill and provides an appropriation from the General Fund to pay 90% of the costs of placing individual flags on the graves of all wartime veterans located in cemeteries where a municipality had previously erected a single flagpole.
