26	After January 1, 2002, a person is guilty of selling a lead sinker if that person sells or offers for sale a lead sinker for fishing that contains any lead and weighs 1/2 ounce or less. For
28	the purposes of this section, "sinker" means any device that is
30	designed to be attached to a fishing line and intended to sind the line. "Sinker" does not include artificial lures, weighted line, weighted flies or jig heads.
