4. Conduct evaluations and provide technical assistance. In conjunction with the Bureau of Rehabilitation Services' staff, conduct accessibility evaluations upon request and provide technical assistance to recreation providers and users with regard to providing access for persons with disabilities.

SUMMARY

This bill repeals the Advisory Committee on Improving Outdoor Recreational Opportunities for Persons with Disabilities and transfers its responsibilities to the Statewide Independent Living Council administered by the Department of Labor, Bureau of Rehabilitation Services, so that recreational opportunities, including indoor recreational activities, are considered within the broader context of independent living issues.
