HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 643, L.D. 893, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Relating to Notaries Public"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out everything after section 3 and before the summary (page 2, lines 1 to 6 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 4. Application. Notarial acts performed by a notary public for that notary public's spouse's child or spouse's sibling are not a conflict of interest if performed before the effective date of this Act.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.'


SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement that notaries maintain records of all notarial acts performed. This amendment
