Further amend the bill in section 4 in the last line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting at the end the following:

4 'Notarial acts performed by a notary public for that notary public's spouse's child or spouse's sibling are not a conflict of
6 interest if performed before the effective date of this Act.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government. This amendment adds a spouse's child to the conflict of interest provisions of the laws governing notaries public. It also removes the requirement that another notary public witness a marriage performed by a notary public for that notary public's spouse's child or spouse's sibling. The amendment removes an expired grandfather clause and grandfathers documents notarized for a notary public's spouse's child or spouse's sibling.
