COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 649, L.D. 899, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Part-time Liquor License"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 20 the following:

'Sec. 21. 28-A MRSA §1051, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

1. Licenses for sale of liquor to be consumed on the premises where sold. Subject to subsection 2, the commission may issue licenses for the sale of spirits, wine and malt liquor to be consumed on the premises where sold to qualified applicants upon payment of fees provided. An applicant may acquire only one part-time license issued pursuant to chapter 41 in a calendar year.

Sec. 22. 28-A MRSA §1201, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

1-A. Part-time licenses. An applicant may acquire only one part-time license issued pursuant to chapter 41 in a calendar year.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

REVENUES

General Fund (\$207,975) (\$277,975)

The establishment of part-time liquor licenses will reduce General Fund revenue collected by the Bureau of Liquor Enforcement within the Department of Public Safety by \$207,975 and \$277,975 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01, respectively.

SUMMARY

This amendment stipulates that only one part-time liquor license may be purchased in a calendar year. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
