An Act Concerning the 1999 Elver Fishery.

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted 2 as emergencies; and Δ Whereas, the elver fishery has sustained a doubling in fishing effort in one year; and б 8 Whereas, it is important that this fishery be managed as a sustainable fishery; and 10 Whereas, the level of fishing pressure experienced in the fishery places this resource at risk; and 12 Whereas, the fishing season in this fishery commences March 14 15th of this year; and 16 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 18 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 20 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, 22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 24 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6001, sub-§13-H, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 91, $\S2$, is amended to read: 26 28 Elver dip net. "Elver dip net" means a dip net with 13-н. a hoop of not more than 30 inches in diameter and fitted with 30 netting that measures 1/8 inch bar mesh or less that is manually operated by one person. 32 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6505-A, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 536, Pt. A, §8, is amended to read: 34 Limits on issuance.  1. 1999 Open season. It is unlawful for a person to fish
for or take elvers within the eeastal waters of the State from June-16th-te-noon-en-March-15th-of-the-following-year except
during the open season between noon on April 1st and noon on May 31st, both dates inclusive.

Setting nets and traps. It is unlawful for a person to
immerse or leave immersed a <u>an elver</u> fyke net or a Sheldon eel
trap in any river, stream or brook of the eeastal waters of the
State from-February-15th-to-noon-of-March-15th <u>at any time other</u>
than the open season for elver fishing.

3. Locating nets. It is unlawful between-February-15th-and

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§6575-A. Closed period; elver harvesting

It is unlawful for a person to fish for or take elvers from 30 noon Friday to noon Sunday. A person may leave an elver fyke net or a Sheldon eel trap in the ceastal waters of the State during 32 the closed period if the net or trap is left in a condition that prevents the capture of elvers. The terminal portion of a fyke 34 net cod end must contain a rigid opening not less than 3 inches in diameter that is unobstructed by any other portion of the 36 net. In addition, the cod end of an elver fyke net must be closed at a point behind the excluder panel where the cod end 38 meets the body of the net so as to prevent elvers from entering the cod end.

2. Number of elver fyke nets and Sheldon eel traps. It is unlawful from noon of March-15th-to-midnight-of June-15th during

A. More than 5 elver fyke nets;

It is a rebuttable presumption 3. that an elver fyke net, Sheldon eel trap or elver dip net 10 immersed in any seastal waters of the State from-noon-of-March 12 15th-to-midnight-of-June-15th at any time of the year is immersed for the purpose of fishing for or taking elvers. 14 Sec. 7. 12 MRSA §6575-B, sub-§6 is enacted to read: 16 6. Artificial platform. It is unlawful for a person to 18 build or use an artificial platform to fish for elvers. This subsection does not prohibit fishing for elvers from piers or 20 floats established for purposes other than elver fishing. Sec. 8. 12 MRSA §6575-C, sub-§5 is enacted to read: 22 24 5. Fyke net separation. It is unlawful for a person to fish for or take elvers with an elver fyke net within the waters 26 of the State when any portion of the net, including any anchoring device, is placed or located within an imaginary line drawn 28 between the wing ends of another elver fyke net. Anchoring devices may not exceed 10 feet in length from the terminal portion of the cod end. In addition, it is unlawful to place an 30 obstruction near an elver fyke net so that it interferes with the 32 lawful placement of another elver fyke net. Sec. 9. 12 MRSA §6575-D, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 34 536, Pt. A, \S 9, are amended to read: 36 1. Prohibition. It is unlawful for any person other than a marine patrol officer or the license holder issued a tag for an 38 elver fyke net or a Sheldon eel trap to utilize, transfer, alter, 40 possess or in any manner handle the net or trap unless that person has been issued an elver fishing license under section 42 6505-A and: Is in the presence of the license holder issued a tag 44 Α. for the net or trap and has the license holder's permission to tend the net or trap; er 46 48 Β. Is issued written permission by a marine patrol officer to tend the net or trap of a license holder issued a tag. A 50 marine patrol officer may issue a person written permission

for the person to tend the license holder's net or trap if 2 the license holder can not tend the net or trap because of a disability or personal or family medical condition; or 4 It is a rebuttable presumption that a person is molesting elver gear when that person tends an elver fyke net or Sheldon eel trap б and the conditions set out in this subsection are not applicable. 8 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved. 10 12 SUMMARY 14 The bill: 16 Clarifies the definition of an elver dip net; 18 Provides that in 2001 the Department of Marine Resources may 20 not issue an elver fishing license once the season has begun; 22 Specifies that the open season for elver fishing is April 1st to May 31st; 24 Specifies that the cod end of a fyke net must have a ridged 26 opening during the time when the net is not allowed to be in fishable condition: 28 Specifies that it is unlawful to build or use an artificial 30 platform for elver fishing; 32 Establishes a separation zone with regard to the placement of fyke nets; and 34 Establishes that it is a rebuttable assumption that an 36 individual is molesting the net of another if that individual is not the person to whom the net tag on the net was issued.
