2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6505-A, sub-§§2-A through 2-F are enacted to
4	read:
6	2-A. Fyke and dip net license. Effective with the issuance of elver licenses in the year 2000, a person may not
8	simultaneously hold an elver fyke net license and an elver dip
10	net license.
12	<u>2-B. Fyke net license: 2000 season. In the year 2000, an</u> elver fyke net license may not be issued to any person unless
14	that person held an elver fyke net license during each of the 3 years of 1996, 1997 and 1998. Persons who gualify for an elver
16	fyke net license are eligible, with the restrictions of section 3, to renew that license through the year 2002 only.
18	2-C. Dip net license; 2000 season. In the year 2000, an
20	elver dip net license may not be issued to any person unless that person held an elver dip net license or any combination of elver
22	licenses during each of the 3 years of 1996, 1997 and 1998.
	2-D. Elver licenses after the 2000 season. In the years
24	2001 and 2002, an elver license may not be issued to any person unless the person held the same type license in the prior
26	calendar year, except that the holder of an elver fyke net license may surrender that license, at the time of renewal only,
28	and is eligible to purchase an elver dip net license subject to
30	the restrictions of section 3. Holders of the year 2002 elver fyke met license are eligible to purchase a year 2003 elver dip
32	net license subject to the restrictions of section 3.
34	<b>2-B. License cap.</b> Beginning January 31, 2003 and in subsequent years, the department may not issue an elver license
	to any person who was not the holder of an elver license in the
36	previous calender years, unless the department has issued fewer than 1000 elver dip licenses in the previous year, The
38	difference between the number of licenses sold in the previous year, when that number is less than 1000, and 1000 will be the
40	number of licenses available on a first-come, first-served basis after January 1 of each subsequent year and subject to the
42	restrictions in section 3.
44	2-F. Nonresident licenses; reciprocity with other states.
46	Beginning January 1, 2000 and in subsequent years the number of nonresident elver licenses must be limited to a number not
4.0	exceeding 1% of the total licenses issued. Nonresidents are
48	<u>eligible to purchase a nonresident elver dip net license only.</u> The only nonresidents eligible to purchase a nonresident elver
50	<u>dip net license are those persons from other states who document</u> to the commissioner that their state of residence allows Maine

2	<u>residents to purchase an elver license and fish for elvers in</u> that state.

8	4-A. Fees. The fees for elver fishing licenses are the
10	amounts listed in the following schedule:
12	A. Beginning January 1, 2000:
14	(1) Resident dipping, \$100 with no additional gear fee;
16	(2) Resident fyke net, \$200 plus gear fee of \$200 per net; and
18	(3) Nonresident dipping, \$200 with no additional gear

22	B. Beginning January 1, 2001:
24	(1) Resident dipping, \$200 with no additional gear fee;
26	(2) Resident fyke net, \$500 plus gear fee of \$500 for 2nd net;

48	Fifty dollars of each license fee collected under this subsection
50	accrues to the General Fund and the balance must accrue to the Eel and Elver Management Fund established in section 6505-D.

5. Gear. A person issued a license under this section may
utilize one elver fyke net, one Sheldon eel trap or one dip net
to fish for or take elvers without paying the fee required for a
first net or trap pursuant to section 6505-B. A license issued
under this section must identify the number and types of nets
that the license holder may use pursuant to this section and
section 6505-B. This subsection is repealed June 1, 2002.

Sec. 5. 12 MRSA 6505-B, sub-1, as amended by PL 1997, c. 14 297, 3 and 4, is further amended to read:

16 1. Elver fyke net and Sheldon eel trap fee. It is unlawful for a person to submerge an elver fyke net or a Sheldon eel trap
 18 in the coastal waters of the State to fish for or take elvers unless the net or trap owner pays annually the following fees
 20 according to the schedule below:

A. Fifty dollars per net or trap for the use of a first or 2nd elver fyke net or Sheldon eel trap, except that the fee
under this paragraph does not apply to an elver fyke or Sheldon eel trap a person utilizes pursuant to section
6505-A, subsection 5. For the purposes of assessing fees under this subsection, an elver fyke net or Sheldon eel trap
utilized pursuant to section 6505-A, subsection 5 is the first net or trap;

B. One hundred dollars per net or trap for the use of a 3rd 32 elver fyke net or Sheldon eel trap; and

- 34 C. Two hundred dollars per net or trap for the use of a 4th and 5th elver fyke net or Sheldon eel trap. :
- D. Beginning with the issuance of an elver fyke net license in the year 2000, a fee of \$200 for the use of each fyke net after the first net;
- E. Beginning with the issuance of an elver fyke net license in the year 2001, a fee of \$500 for the use of a 2nd net; and
- 44 F. No additional fee for the single net allowed for the 2002 season.

1-A. Open and closed seasons in 2000. It is unlawful to
 fish for or take elvers with an elver fyke net or Sheldon eel

 open season between noon on April 1st and noon on May 15th, both
 dates inclusive. It is unlawful to fish for or take elvers with
 an elver dip net with in the coastal waters of the State except
 during the open season between noon on April 1st and noon on May

4 It is unlawful for a person to fish for or take elvers from a boat. This section is effective June 1, 2002. б 8 **SUMMARY** 10 This bill establishes a limitation on the number of licenses that may be sold in any year and a mechanism for bringing new people into the fishery as licenses become available through 12 attrition. It establishes a fee schedule for licenses and for elver fishing gear. It increases the number of eels that an 14 individual may take for personal purposes and it specifies the 16 open and closed seasons for the elver fishery for the years 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003. 18 The bill also repeals and replaces the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6575-A that allows individuals to 20 place a new net or trap in coastal waters during the closed period if the net is not in a fishable condition and it 22 establishes the amount of elver fishing gear that may be used in 24 the years 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2002 and that in the year 2003, only dip nets may be used in the elver fishery.
