FISCAL NOTE

This amendment delays the effective date of this bill until October 1, 2000. This reduces the cost of the bill. As amended, this bill provides a General Fund appropriation of \$44,066 in fiscal year 2000-01 and will reduce individual income tax collections by \$39,270 in fiscal year 2000-01. This reduction will decrease the amounts transferred to the Local Government Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing by \$2,003 in that fiscal year, resulting in a reduction of General Fund revenue of \$37,267 in fiscal year 2000-01. The General Fund cost of this bill in fiscal year 2000-01 is \$81,333.
