22	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

With respect to services provided by psychologists, this subsection applies to all contracts between the subscriber 34 and a nonprofit hospital or medical service organization entered 36 into or renewed after January 1, 1976.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

Mental health services provided by counseling A health maintenance organization that issues professionals. individual or group health care contracts providing coverage for mental health services shall effer provide coverage for those services when performed by a counseling--professional--who--is licensed-by-the-State-pursuant-to-Title-32, -chapter-119-te-assess and-treat-interpersonal-and-intrapersonal-problems,-has-at-least a--masters--degree--in--counseling--or--a-related--field--frem--an accredited--educational--institution--and--has--been--employed--as seunseler-for-at--least-2-years licensed clinical professional counselor, licensed marriage and family therapist or licensed pastoral counselor, acting within the scope of that license. 42	The Bureau of Insurance within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation will incur some minor	
44	additional costs to review additional insurance contract filings. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's

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for this mandated benefit. Assuming future contracts will

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contain the same level of coverage, this bill will not increase the costs of the State's health insurance plan.

This bill will increase the costs of some of the retired teachers health insurance plans. The State pays for 30% of the eligible premiums for retired teachers health insurance. This bill includes an additional General Fund appropriation of \$19,150 in fiscal year 2000-01 for the Department of Education to provide funding to the Retired Teachers' Health Insurance program for the State's share of the premium increases associated with this mandated benefit. This estimate is based on increased usage and is from the 1995 mandated benefit study conducted by the Bureau of Insurance. This estimate will likely be used in initial rate setting. Future costs may vary from this amount depending on the experience of the health insurance plans affected by this mandated benefit.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It clarifies that nonprofit hospital and medical service organizations, insurers and health maintenance organizations are required to provide reimbursement for the services of licensed clinical professional counselors, licensed marriage and family therapists and licensed pastoral counselors and not other categories of licensed counseling professionals.

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The amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.

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
