Edmunds, shall convey the property to the Town of Edmunds to be used exclusively for public purposes.'

'FISCAL NOTE

This resolve will result in the eventual transfer of a parcel of property from the Town of Dennysville to the Bureau of Public Lands within the Department of Conservation and then finally to the Dennys River Historical Society. The department will not realize any financial gain from the transfer of this property.

20 The Bureau of Public Lands will incur some minor additional costs to prepare the deed to convey a certain property to the 22 Dennys River Historical Society. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

28 This amendment makes technical changes to the resolve providing a preamble and cross-references and clarifies that the 30 property that is to be transferred to the Dennys River Historical Society is located in Edmunds. It also provides that the 32 property be conveyed to Edmunds if the township of Edmunds becomes incorporated as a town. It also adds a fiscal note to 34 the resolve.
