	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7457, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

	4. Juvenile hunters. A person who is between 10 and 17
6	years of age and who holds a license that authorizes the hunting
	of deer may take either a deer with antlers or an antlerless deer
8	if that person has never before taken a deer. If the person has
	taken a deer in a previous hunting season, that person may not
10	take an antlerless deer unless the deer is taken in accordance
	with rules under subsection 1, paragraph H regarding the taking
12	of antlerless deer.
