Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 6 in the 4th line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>Maine State Retirement System</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>State</u>'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the 34 following:

36 'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

30	SUMMARY
32	This amendment clarifies that it is the responsibility of the State to pay the Medicare Part B premiums required in the

34 bill. The amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
