### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §374, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

6. Reduce hunger lottery game. No later than January 30, 2000, the commission in conjunction with the Department of Education and the Department of Human Services shall develop and initiate a reduce hunger lottery game designed to raise funds for the school lunch program and for food for children of low-income families. The commission shall forward the net proceeds of the game to the Treasurer of State for deposit in separate accounts. The funds must be used for the purposes described in this subsection. The commission shall change the reduce hunger ticket periodically throughout the year.

#### **SUMMARY**

This bill creates a lottery ticket to reduce hunger in Maine. The net proceeds from the sale of the tickets must be distributed equally between 2 separate accounts to benefit the school lunch program and help provide food for children of low-income families.
