This amendment includes deappropriations equal to the appropriations of \$27,500 and \$441,750 in fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01 respectively, resulting in no net General Fund appropriations, from the elimination of 2 House Chamber Staff positions and one Senate Chamber Staff position beginning in fiscal year 2000-01 and through reductions in the All Other line category, some of which may be available as a result of savings in printing costs due to the implementation of an automated, integrated computer system for managing legislative activity and information. The effect of these deappropriations on legislative operations can not be determined at this time.
