## **SUMMARY**

4 This is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation. The amendment changes the title of the bill 6 and replaces the bill.

8 The amendment requires reflective material or lamps that are visible to oncoming traffic on the front corners of trailers that 10 are wider than the vehicle towing the trailer. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
